Neurology News

Departure of the Head of University Neurorehabilitation, Prof. René Müri

After 26 years in Neurology, including 18 years as Head of University Neurorehabilitation at the Bern and Riggisberg sites, Prof. René Müri retired in September 2021. As co-head, he helped found the interdisciplinary Memory Clinic at the Inselspital, developed the Perception and Oculomotor Laboratory and was also the clinical co-head of the Gerontechnology and Rehabilitation research group at the ARTORG research center of the University of Bern.

Prof. Adrian Guggisberg New Head of University Neurorehabilitation


Prof. Adrian Guggisberg started as the Head of University Neurorehabilitation at the Inselspital on August 1, 2021, taking over from Prof. René Müri. In this function, he will manage the planned expansion of Riggisberg Hospital and the implementation of the model of graduated neurorehabilitation.

Prof. Guggisberg completed his doctorate at the University of Bern in 2001 and undertook his internship at the Inselspital, Tiefenau Hospital and the University Hospital of Geneva, receiving his specialist qualification in Neurology in 2009. Since then he has worked and studied at the University Hospital of Geneva, where he was appointed Associate Professor on October 1, 2018.

Reorganization of Nursing Management

Rosmarie Wyss led Nursing Services for 26 years before retiring in the fall of 2021. Nursing has been a part of the independent Nursing Organization with its own budget since January 1, 2021. The function of the Head of Nursing Services was taken over by the Head of Department, led by Head of Nursing of the Neuro department, Ms Barbara Zurschmiede-Dupras.

Martina Siffert has led the department of Nursing in Acute Neurology and the Stroke Unit since September 1, 2021. Claudia Kuster is the new Head of Department for Nursing in Neurorehabilitation and Psychosomatics. Both Nursing Department heads have been working for several years in Neurology and/or at the Inselspital; they now join the Department Management.



Medical Co-Directors of the Psychosomatic Medicine Area

Dr. Nina Bischoff and Prof. Dr. Selma Aybek have been leading the Psychosomatic Medicine area in a temporary capacity since September 2020. They were able to develop the area successfully in this time. The Department Management thus decided in June 2021 to confirm them as Co-Directors of this area.

Opening of the NeuroTec Research Platform

The University Hospital Department of Neurology, together with the University of Bern and sitem-insel, opened the NeuroTec research platform in the fall.



In the context of its translational research activity, NeuroTec investigates the use of modern medical technology for improved treatment of neurological disorders, with the goal of increasing the shift of diagnosis and therapy from the hospital to the home. www. neuro-tec.ch

Equal Opportunity Board

In its meeting on September 6, 2021, the Department Management voted to found a new board to promote and support equal opportunities of men and women in the clinical and academic Neurology setting. Prof. Selma Aybek, Assoc. Lect. Anke Salmen and Prof. Athina Tzovara will share the chairing of the board. The University Hospital Department of Neurology has set itself the goal of strengthening and embedding equal opportunities in all areas of the Department and Research.

Reorganization of the Outpatient Neurocenter (ANZ) Administration

A project to reorganize the administration of the outpatient department began in summer 2021 under the leadership of Beatrix Grigioni, Head of Administration of the ANZ. Organizing the staff into specialist areas allows redundancies to be avoided in the future and collaboration to be improved. The digitalization strategy at the Insel can also be pushed ahead at the same time.



Redesign of the Website

The Department website with the new corporate design of the Insel Group has been online since last summer. New structures simplify web searches for both patients and referrers.


One main focus has been the expansion of the Research website, whereby each research group now has their own page.

Teaching and Research

The University Hospital Department of Neurology has over 60 interns and is thus the largest neurology training facility in Switzerland. It is distinguished by very broad neurology training and the support of scientific assistants, also shown in the training curriculum for assistants.

For the 2020 reporting year, the Department of Neurology placed first in the Medical Faculty's research evaluation. Of the Inselspital and UPD's 38 departments and institutes, Neurology achieved the overall top performance in the areas of publications, citations and third-party funds.

Maxime Baud Receives the SNSF Eccellenza Professorial Fellowship

The Eccelenza research prize, designed to support young researchers in developing their own research field, was awarded by the Swiss National Science Foundation for the final time in 2021. One of the prize winners was Dr. med. et Dr. phil. nat. Maxime Baud, Senior Physician at the Sleeping-Waking Epilepsy Center (SWEZ). His research project «Dynamical Control of Seizures» allows reliable prediction of epileptic seizures.

SNSF Ambizione Grant for Dr. med. Gerd Tinkhauser

Dr. med. Gerd Tinkhauser has received an Ambizione grant for his project «Adaptive neuromodulation in movement disorders – a precision medicine approach», which runs for 4 years. Apart from his own salary and funding for one postdoc and one PhD student, the grant also covers project materials.

Extension of the Interfaculty Sleep Research Collaboration

The interfaculty research collaboration (IFK) «Decoding Sleep», funded by the University of Bern, has spent the past 2 years reorienting sleep research at a local level including various disciplines and networking these internationally. The University Management has thus decided to extend the IFK under the leadership of Prof. Claudio Bassetti for a further 2 years with an annual budget of CHF 1.5 million.

Strategic Research Funding of the Medical Faculty

The Strategic Research Funding of the Medical Faculty is supporting the project «A digital reference network platform for clinical and experimental neuroscience – deep phenotyping and data integration» under the leadership of Prof. R. Wiest (Neuroradiology), Prof. A. Chan (Neurology) and Prof. T. Nef (ARTORG) with CHF 800 000 for a duration of 2 years.

Fellowships

The internal funding program for young researchers sought applications again in 2021. Grants for «protected research time» were awarded in the form of the «Excellence in Diversity Fellowships», the funding instrument for female researchers. The «Research Grants in Neurology» and «Bridge Scholarships in Translational Research in Neurology» were also again highly successful.

Third-party Funding and Grants

The third-party funding disbursed by the SNSF in 2021 totalled CHF 2.1 million and was thus slightly below that of the preceding year. The remaining competitive grants totalled CHF 3.28 million.

Start of the Continuing Education Program MAS Stroke Medicine

The MAS Stroke Medicine continuing education program started in spring 2022. The CME program was conceived by Prof. Urs Fischer in Bern and is oriented to medical practitioners, researchers and other healthcare professionals and covers the entire spectrum of stroke care and research over five semesters.

An attractive learning platform has been created under the leadership of Prof. Simon Jung, the Chair of the Program Committee, that allows students from around the world access to the study materials. The contents have been provided from the most renowned stroke experts from around the world.

Launch of the Dementia Symposium

In early 2022, the Department will hold its first symposium on the topic of dementia under the leadership of Prof. Claudio Bassetti. The Neurocenter offers a



comprehensive range of services for the diagnosis and care of patients; it has conducted the highest quality dementia research for several years. The University Hospital Department of Neurology will also be able to fill a Professorial Chair for Dementia in 2022.

Opening of the Swiss Sleep House Bern

The University Hospital Department of Neurology will open the Swiss Sleep House Bern at the Tiefenau Hospital site on November 29, 2022. This forms the first center of excellence for sleeping and sleep health in Switzerland, providing a point of contact and consultation service for people and companies with questions and problems regarding sleep.
